Dear Divisional Youth Secretaries and Corps Officers,

Asbury University offers a visit weekend specifically for Salvation Army students! During the Salvation Army Visit Weekend you will attend university classes, chapel, meet Asbury's Salvation Army staff and students, and learn about the financial aid opportunities.

Asbury University will be holding Winter ACCESS Days from **January 25-28, 2018**. On ACCESS Days prospective students meet approximately 50 other students interested in Asbury College, experience what the current Asbury College students are like and could possibly meet future classmates. **Regardless of where students attend college, a campus visit is imperative before making a final decision.**

Daniel Osborne, a sophomore from Union, Ky., said about his campus visit, "Visiting Asbury is the only way to get a real feel of community. People can talk about it on Web sites and in reports, but until someone visits, they can't really grasp how powerful the communal aspect of college is."

Asbury University is offering a visit weekend ***specifically for Salvation Army students!***

This is a great opportunity for juniors and seniors in high school to experience the Asbury community firsthand. Students will explore majors, attend classes, worship in chapel and spend the night in a residence hall.

During the Salvation Army Visit Weekend students will meet Asbury's Salvation Army staff and students, learn about the financial aid opportunities for Salvationists, and get more familiar with Asbury Campus.

The ACCESS schedule will conclude early Friday evening. Immediately following the Admissions-Office sponsored event, The Salvation Army delegates will then have opportunity to experience SASF (Salvation Army Student Fellowship) community firsthand for the rest of the weekend.

The SASF (Salvation Army Student Fellowship) will provide opportunities to visit the Moulton Memorial Student Center, meet The Salvation Army students who are enrolled in the University, as well as experience fun and fellowship events in Wilmore and surrounding communities. This portion of the visitation weekend will conclude after Sunday morning worship with the SASF.

Frequently Asked Questions

How Much Does It Cost?

- ACCESS Days are **free** to attend.
- In addition, Asbury will cover the cost of breakfast and lunch on Friday for visiting students and their family. Students will need meal money for food to and from Asbury.
- Territorial Headquarters will be providing transportation from THQ. We will leave on Thursday morning and return on Sunday evening.
- If there are vans traveling from other divisions, THQ will pay for the cost of the gas.

What Should I Bring?

- **Everyone needs the permission slip and the medical permission slip filled out and signed by your parent or guardian.**
- If you play an instrument bring it.
- Warm clothing
- If you have a uniform, please bring it.
- Clothes for Sunday
- Sleeping bag , pillow, Towels
- Bible
- Money for lunch on the way down and dinner on the way back and spending money for souvenirs.
- The trip to Lexington, Kentucky is 726 miles. It will take approximately 6 1/2 hours. Make sure to bring your earbuds ☺

What Are the Student Housing Options?

- Students are invited to stay on campus and get the real college experience in one of Asbury's residence halls.
